Healthy Kids Foundation	The Club paid the insurances for junior players of the Camden Valley Basketball Association (The Wildfires). This enables a cheaper registration cost to families by individual sporting groups, thus allowing families to be able to afford for their children to participate in an active, healthy lifestyle in low social economic areas in the Campbelltown LGA. These payments are made direct to the Provider of the Insurance or the Governing Body of the sport.
