Heart of the Nation	To provide 2 x community accessible AED packages to Lakeside Golf Club, so community members can assist in the event a sudden cardiac arrest occurring.	\$5,980.00
Narellan Men's Shed	This project sought funding to purchase small tools, equipment and accessories and related consumables.
