ClubGRANTS is a community funding scheme that ensures larger registered clubs in NSW contribute to the provision of front-line services in their local communities and provide much-needed support to community organisations, groups, and disadvantaged members of the community.

West's Group Macarthur is incredibly proud of the support we offer our community via the ClubGRANTS program.

Eligible Category 2 funding is available for projects that promote community development and support activities not listed under Category 1, including grassroots sport, returned servicemen's league and veteran welfare aimed at residents of Campbelltown, Camden and, or being delivered within the Campbelltown, Camden and immediate surrounds. Our Community Team reviews all grant submissions, favouring those with a focus on supporting not-for-profits and local community groups within the Macarthur region.



Important Dates

- Applications open Sunday 1st of September 2025
- Applications close Sunday 31st of August 2026

All applicants will be contacted via email to confirm the application outcome.

Eligibility- Who can't apply

- Individuals
- Organisations or businesses that may or will realise a commercial gain from the project.
- If you have an "open" grant that has not been acquitted from a previous round, you will not be eligible for consideration in the current round

ClubGRANTS Purpose

Projects must align with one of the categories listed in the 'ClubGRANTS Purpose' list to be considered by Community Team.

- Health
- Community Activities
- Club Facilities (Internal Use Only)
- Medical Research
- Local Committees (Internal Use Only)
- Cultural Activities
- Other

Application Process

- Step 1:** Check your eligibility
- Step 2:** Understand the requirements
- Step 3:** Prepare your application
- Step 4:** Submit your application

When creating an account, please use a generic email address so it can be accessed by multiple users in the event of a personal change within our organization.

Funded projects exceeding \$7,500 will require additional documentation and a contract, which will be initiated by the funding club.
