Eligible Category 2 expenditure is available for grassroots sports, veteran welfare activities and community development and support activities not listed under Category 1 benefiting residents of Campbelltown and Camden.

ClubGRANTS is a community funding program that ensures larger registered clubs in NSW contribute to the provision of frontline services to their local communities; while supporting disadvantaged community members to benefit from the substantial contributions made by these clubs. The program also provides funding for grassroots sports, veteran welfare activities and community development.

OUTCOMES ADVISED

ELIGIBILITY (WHO CAN'T APPLY)

- ✗ Individuals (including sole traders), organisations or businesses that may or will realise a commercial gain from the project.
- ✗ Schools (or Government funded). P & F committees may apply for extracurricular services that support disadvantaged students or for out-of-hours programs for at-risk students. However, they must consider whether and how the project will be accessible to the public outside school hours.
- ✗ If your organisation has an open grant from a previous funding round, please ensure all reporting requirements have been submitted to remain eligible for future funding.

CLUBGRANTS PURPOSE

To be eligible for funding, projects must align with one of the categories outlined in the ClubGRANTS Purpose and must be delivered within or provide benefit to **residents of Campbelltown and Camden**.
